THE CONGREGATION: Ye shall keep my sabbaths, and reverence my sanctuary; I am the Lord. Leviticus 19:30

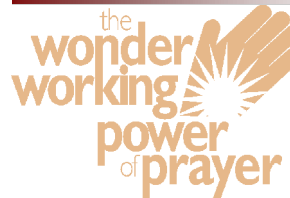
LEADER: And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. Matthew 16:18
