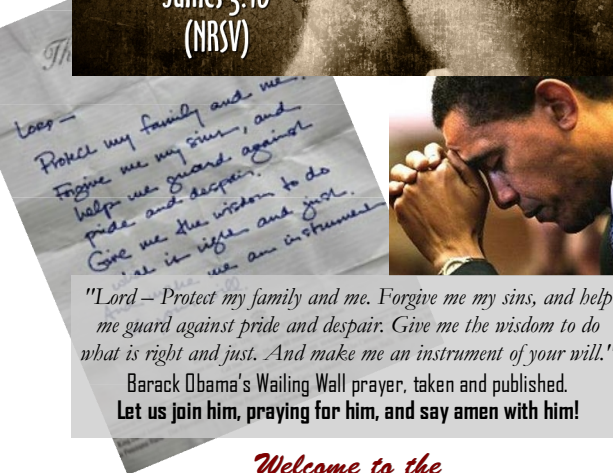

THE CONGREGATION: Ye shall keep my **sabbaths,** and reverence my **sanctuary;** I am the Lord. Leviticus 19:30

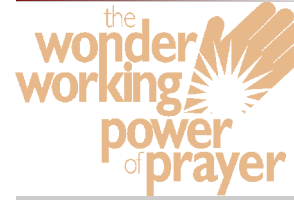
